Volunteer Firefighter, EMT, AND SAR Pension Fund Board Meeting Via Zoom June 16, 2020

A meeting of the Volunteer Firefighter, EMT, and Search & Rescue Pension Fund Board was held at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, June 16, 2020 via Zoom.

Chairman Diedtrich called the meeting to order at 9:50 a.m.

1) Board Meeting Minutes from January 9, 2020. The Volunteer Firefighter, EMT, and SAR Pension Fund minutes from January, 2020 were considered.

MOTION 06-16-2020 (#1): Mr. Sessions moved to approve the minutes as presented. Mr. Applegate seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

2) Review of Financial Reports. The financial statements for October, November, Denver 2019 and January 2020 were reviewed, noting that plan assets as of January 31, 2012 totaled \$93,604,777.06.

MOTION 06-16-2020 (#2): Mr. Quinney moved to approve the financial reports as presented. Mr. Brown seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

3) Review of Membership Reports. The membership reports as of December 31, 2019 contained the following highlights:

Active Contributing Members: 2,417 Retirees: 1,288 Survivor pensions: 267 Monthly pension total: \$551,786.28 Smallest monthly pension: \$35.14 Largest monthly pension: \$731.58

<u>Participating Departments</u>. The Board reviewed the participating department report, noting 121 participating agencies.

<u>Service Purchase reports</u>. The Board reviewed the service purchase reports for the quarter, with five pending service purchases during the April - June timeframe.

<u>Newly refunded and retired report</u>. The Board reviewed the refunded accounts and new retirees for the April - June timeframe. There were 4 new retirements, and 18 members refunded their accounts during the period.

<u>Deceased members by plan report</u>. The report shows 3 retirees and survivors who passed.

MOTION 06-16-2020 (#3): Mr. Applegate moved to approve the membership reports. Mr. Sessions seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

4) Review of Results and Recommendations on Fire Department Meeting Attendance Audits. Mr. Waddell introduced WRS new Audit Manager Ms. Meeker. Mr. Waddell reviewed his report which included four individuals who were not in compliance.

MOTION 06-16-2020 (#4): Mr. Applegate moved to suspend the four delinquent individuals. Mr. Brown seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board discussed a WRS Memo concerning virtual meetings during this COVID-19 pandemic.

MOTION 06-16-2020 (#5): Mr. Quinney moved to accept the Audit Committee findings and approve the recommendations in the memo. Mr. Brown seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

5) Other Matters
