Volunteer Firemen's Pension Fund Board Meeting - Afton, Wyoming September 13, 2013

A meeting of the Volunteer Firemen's Pension Fund Board was held at 1:30 P.M. on Friday, September 13, 2013 at the Fire Hall in Afton, Wyoming.

Board Members participating were: Mr. Lanny Applegate, Mr. Gene Diedtrich, Mr. Kim Lee, and Mr. Alan Sessions.

Attending by phone were Mr. Tracy Brown and Mr. Jerry Munger.

Others in attendance were: Mr. Conn Astle from Afton and Mr. Noel Sessions from Afton.

Ms. Ruth Ryerson and Mr. Harry Wales represented the Wyoming Retirement System.

Board Meeting Minutes: The *Volunteer Firemen's Pension Fund Board Meeting Minutes* for June 12, 2013 were considered. Mr. Brown indicated that on page three, paragraph four, that the word percent has been omitted after the number 50. Thereby the minutes for this should read "Mr. Wales then began the discussion on Section 4(a) Department Meetings and Mr. Lee suggested we use the language in the current rule that states volunteers must attend 50 percent ..."

MOTION 09-13-13 (#1): Mr. Applegate moved to accept the minutes as amended. Mr. Lee seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Financial Statements: The *Financial Statements* for the months of May, June and July 2013 were reviewed.

MOTION 09-13-13 (#2): Mr. Diedtrich moved that the Financial Statements be approved as presented. Mr. Sessions seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

A brief discussion was held on the Premium Tax transfers schedule. Mr. Wales pointed out that the plan had received an additional \$386,645 on August 27. So the total to date with the accrual for 2012 is \$1,946,511 and \$1,101,642.30 without the accrual.

Membership Reports: The *Membership Reports* for August 31, 2013 discloses that there were 7,103 total members that have participated in the program with 2,229 active contributing members, 956 retirees and 183 survivor pensions at August 31. The smallest monthly pension paid is \$38.40 and the largest monthly pension paid was shown as \$689.62.

The reports also disclosed that at August 31 there were 104 agencies reporting to the pension plan. Since May 31, 2013, there has been a decrease of 2 active volunteers reporting. The list of Refunds and list of Current Retirees were then reviewed. Also noted were two volunteers who had termed and requested relatively large refunds of their contributions and interest. Also, 13 additional volunteer firemen that have officially retired and are now receiving pension benefits since the last board meeting. The list of Retirees was reviewed.

Mr. Applegate asked Mr. Wales how many departments would be eligible to participate. Mr. Diedtrich answered that there are 154 departments eligible to join the pension plan. Discussion

was made about whether or not any effort was made to contact these departments. Mr. Wales said he'd try to utilize the Fire Marshall's web site to determine what departments are currently participating. Mr. Diedtrich said that he had a list in electronic form with mailing addresses that he would send to Mr. Wales. Mr. Munger mentioned that there may be some members may be doubled up in some departments and to watch for that.

MOTION: 09-13-13 (#3) Mr. Brown moved that the Membership Reports be approved. Mr. Diedtrich seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Next on the agenda was an update of Chapter 1 of the rules that are in the process of being updated pursuant to the Governor's mandate. Mr. Wales pointed out that Chapter 1, General Provisions has been changed to incorporate language regarding "retirement age".

Mr. Wales then began the discussion on several sections of the rule indicating the incorporation of other Chapter rules. With those being incorporated into Chapter One, those other chapters will be removed. In regard to Section 4(b) Department Meetings, Mr. Wales was reminded that at the June meeting, Mr. Lee suggested we use the language in the current rule that states volunteers must attend 50 of the business or training meetings or a minimum of six (6) meetings during a calendar year. Mr. Wales stated he would see that this language gets incorporated into the rule and the Board requested to review the rule prior to advertising them. Mr. Wales said he would send the Board a final draft for their approval.

A question came up about whether or not the interest on the inactive accounts could be retroactively adjusted to only give them three months of interest as well. Mr. Wales said he'd check with the staff attorney and get back to them on an answer.

Mr. Wales then went through the last page of key points to get the Board's support for or lack thereof on:

- 1) There is no (vesting) in this plan. Members become eligible for a benefit upon reaching retirement age (Section 2);
- 2) A member that ceases to make contributions to the fund prior to reaching retirement age shall be required to withdraw contributions and interest. Members will no longer be allowed to keep money on deposit and will not be eligible for a reduced benefit at retirement age. All members must continuously contribute to the plan until retirement age to be eligible for a benefit.
- 3) Members shall be allowed to purchase actual service accrued prior to joining the plan (not restricted to one-year increments).
- 4) Members who have contributed for 10 years will be allowed to continue contributing after they have terminated service as a volunteer (which means removed from the rolls). Members with less than 10 years shall be required to withdraw.
- 5) Members shall have 3 months to make-up contributions (statutory), after which they will be forced to withdraw. No interest will accrue on accounts that should be withdrawn but for which we can't locate the member.
- 6) The meeting requirement now requires departments to maintain a regular meeting schedule for business and training and for members to attend 50 percent of those meetings. The intent here is departments should determine an appropriate meeting schedule; WRS doesn't have the authority

to dictate to departments what their meeting schedules should be or what kinds of meetings are required. Each department can determine its schedule and members must then attend half of those meetings.

NOTE: the board suggested including language with a minimum of six (6) meetings.

7) Chapter 2 (Meetings) is proposed to be repealed (see 6 above).

8) Chapter 4 (Contested Cases) is proposed to be repealed and the Office of Administrative Hearings rules on appeals is proposed to be incorporated by reference into Chapter 1 (Section 6(a)).

9) Chapter 3 (Member Records) is proposed to be repealed and the records rule from the WRB is proposed to be incorporated by reference into Chapter 1 (Section 6(b)).


MOTION: 09-13-13 (#4) Mr. Sessions moved to approve the rule with the stipulation that Mr. Wales provide the board a clean copy of the rule with the changes discussed. Mr. Brown seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Next on the agenda was a discussion on the administrative costs. Ms. Ryerson stated that she is having WRS's external compliance auditor prepare an analysis of administrative expenses like they used in Colorado and would provide the board an example. Ms. Ryerson mentioned that in Colorado, they used net assets as the method to allocate expenses and for smaller plans it benefits them using that method. Ms. Ryerson told the Board that the new method would be in place possibly by the fourth quarter of 2013 or first quarter of 2014.

Mr. Wales brought to the Board's attention that the JAC meets on October 28 in Casper and that there is a proposed bill sponsored by the JAC that would transfer some of the fire premium tax to the Volunteer EMT pension plan and that it would appear a portion that currently goes into the General Fund would be allocated to their plan. Mr. Diedtrich mentioned it was his impression that the JAC may be looking at providing the Paid Fire Plan A with the general fund portion of the premium tax. Mr. Applegate also mentioned that rumor is the volunteer EMTs in Fremont County may be going to paid positions therefore the number of volunteers will decrease. Mr. Lee suggested that the volunteer EMTs join their local fire department. He mentioned that not all volunteer firemen go out on fire calls and this could be a possible solution for them. Mr. Brown suggested that the EMT's find their own source of funding and Mr. Wales responded that at the EMT board meeting in August, there were three or four possible sources identified. Mr. Wales and Ms. Ryerson mentioned if at all possible that someone from this Board attend the JAC meeting on the 28th.

The next meeting of the Volunteer Firemen's Pension Board will be on January 9, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at Sivilars in Hudson, Wyoming.

Adjournment: With no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 2:45 P.M.

RULES OF PRACTICE GOVERNING ADMINISTRATION OF THE VOLUNTEER
FIREMEN'S PENSION FUND

Chapter 1

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 1. **Authority.** This Chapter is promulgated under the authority of W.S. § 35-9-611.

Section 2. **Retirement Age.** "Retirement age" means the age at which a participating member retires from active service as a volunteer fireman and is eligible to receive retirement benefits from the Volunteer Firemen's Pension Fund ("Fund"), pursuant to the table of benefits articulated in W.S. § 35-9-608.

(a) A member shall not be eligible for a retirement benefit prior to obtaining retirement age.

(b) Any member who ceases contributions prior to obtaining retirement age shall be required to withdraw those contributions and interest, regardless of years of service.

(c) A member who enters the Fund at an age that exceeds the highest entry age depicted in the table of benefits must make contributions for a minimum of five (5) continuous years in order to become eligible for a retirement benefit. The member's benefit upon retirement shall equate to the benefit amount of the highest entry age and retirement age depicted in the table of benefits.

Section 3. **Service.**

(a) **Military Service.** In accordance with the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act (USERRA), 38 U.S.C. 4301, and the Wyoming Military Service Relief Act (WMSRA), W.S. § 19-11-101 through W.S. § 19-11-124, any participating member called to active duty in the armed forces of the United States or in the Wyoming National Guard shall not be required to withdraw from the Fund during periods of active military service.

(i) Any participating member may elect to continue to make the required contributions to the Fund during a period of active military service. The member shall notify the volunteer fire department of his election to continue to make the required contributions at the time he enters active military service and make arrangements to submit timely contributions. The department shall remit the contributions to the retirement system with the regular monthly member contributions.

(ii) Any participating member who elects not to make pension contributions during a period of active military service shall be permitted to make a lump-sum payment to the Fund for the purpose of receiving creditable service in the retirement system covering the period of the member's active military service. Upon such payment, the member shall be credited as though no break in service occurred. Payment under this section shall only be authorized following the member's notice to a duly constituted volunteer fire department in Wyoming of the member's intent to rejoin the active roles of the department. Notice of intent to return to the active roles of a department shall be made within the timeframes stipulated in W.S. § 19-11-111(e) of WMSRA. Any member that does not rejoin the regular rolls of a duly constituted volunteer fire department in Wyoming following return from active military service must withdraw from the Fund in accordance with these rules.

(A) USERRA authorizes lump-sum payments made pursuant to this section to be made during time periods beginning with the date the member rejoins the regular roles of a duly constituted volunteer fire department in Wyoming following active military service and ending not more than three times the period of the member's active military service. Any payment to the Fund made during a time frame described in this paragraph shall be an amount equal to the employee contributions that would have been paid had the member continued regular contributions to the Fund, without interest.

(B) WMSRA authorizes lump-sum payments made pursuant to this section to be made within five (5) years of the date the member rejoins the regular roles of a duly constituted volunteer fire department in Wyoming following active military service. Any payment to the Fund made after the expiration of the time period authorized by USERRA and prior to the time frame described in this paragraph shall be an amount equal to the make-up employee contributions, together with interest.

(b) **Service Purchase.** Any member shall be entitled to make a lump-sum payment, in an actuarially determined amount, for the purpose of receiving service credit for actual service as a volunteer fireman in Wyoming prior to enrollment, or re-enrollment, in the Fund. Service purchased pursuant to this section shall not exceed the total actual service as a bona fide volunteer fireman in Wyoming prior to the member's enrollment, or re-enrollment, in the Fund. The entry age of a member who exercises this option shall reflect the service purchase.

(c) **Continuation of Contributions Following Termination of Active Service.** Any member who has contributed to the Fund for at least ten (10) consecutive years and who terminates active service as a volunteer fireman shall be permitted to continue contributing to the Fund until the member obtains retirement age. Any member who has not contributed to the Fund for at least ten (10) consecutive years and who terminates active service as a volunteer fireman shall not be eligible to continue contributing to the Fund and shall be required to withdraw those contributions and interest in accordance with these rules. A member who terminates active service as a

volunteer fireman is one who is no longer carried on the regular rolls of the volunteer fire department to which he served as an active member.

(d) **Withdrawal.** Any member who, for any reason, ceases contributions prior to obtaining retirement age shall be required to contact the Wyoming Retirement System and withdraw from the Fund. A member who withdraws from the Fund shall be paid a distribution of the accumulated contributions and interest in the member's account. Members shall have three (3) months from the close of the first calendar month for which contributions have not been received by the Fund to make appropriate payments. An account for which appropriate payments have not been received within that timeframe shall be deemed delinquent. No interest shall accrue on delinquent accounts. An account that remains delinquent for nine (9) months shall be closed and the associated funds shall be absorbed by the Fund. A member whose account was closed pursuant to these rules who subsequently re-enrolls in the Fund shall be entitled to a refund equal to the amount that was absorbed by the Fund upon the closing of the account. A re-enrolled member shall be entitled to a service purchase in accordance with these rules covering the period of prior participation in the Fund.

(e) **Termination of Active Service due to Disability.** The Board may permit a disabled member to continue contributing to the Fund if termination is due to disability, regardless of the member's years of service. Application for disability shall be made to the Board and supported by at least one medical doctor attesting that the member's disability prevents the member from continuing to serve as an active volunteer fireman.

Section 4. **Meetings.**

(a) **Board Meetings.** Board meetings shall be held at least annually according to a schedule adopted by the Board. All Board meetings are subject to the Wyoming Public Meetings Act, W.S. §§ 16-4-401 through 16-4-408.

(b) **Department Meetings.** Volunteer fire departments shall maintain a regular meeting schedule to conduct business and training. In order to maintain membership in the Fund, a member shall attend at least 50 percent, and in no case less than six, of the regularly scheduled department meetings during a calendar year. All members carried on the regular rolls of a duly constituted volunteer fire department must adhere to this requirement.

Section 5. **Contested Cases.** Any member adversely affected by a decision of the Board may appeal the decision by filing a written notice of appeal with the Board within thirty (30) days of the decision. The written notice shall articulate the member's name and address, the specific decision to be appealed, a clear statement of the facts on which the appeal is based and the specific relief sought by the member.

Section 6. **Incorporated by Reference.**

(a) **Appeals.** Upon appeal, a hearing will be scheduled in accordance with the Office of Administrative Hearings Rules, Chapter 2, Contested Case Proceedings, edition May 7, 2008, hereby incorporated by reference. The incorporated material does not include any later amendments or additions. The material may be inspected, copied at cost, or obtained at the Wyoming Retirement System, 6101 Yellowstone Road, Suite 500, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. A decision by the Board following appeal is a final agency decision subject to judicial review.

(b) **Records.** The Rules Governing the Wyoming Retirement Board as Administrator of the Wyoming Retirement System, Chapter 10, Member Account Records, edition January 26, 1994, are hereby incorporated by reference. The incorporated material does not include any later amendments or additions. **Rules and Regulations for the Volunteer Firemen's Pension Board
Intent to Amend and Repeal Rules**

STATEMENT OF PRINCIPAL REASONS

Pursuant to the authority granted by W.S. 35-9-611 of the Wyoming state statutes pertaining to administration of the Volunteer Firemen's Pension Fund (Fund), the Volunteer Firemen's Pension Board (Board) has decided to amend its administrative rules.

The Board is proposing to amend Chapter 1 of its rules for the purpose of streamlining and clarifying administrative procedures. Additionally, the Board is proposing to repeal Chapters 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the rules. These rules are either redundant, superfluous or are otherwise proposed to be incorporated directly into, or by reference into, Chapter 1 of the amended rules. Specific information regarding the proposed changes is articulated in this statement.

Because the proposed amendments to Chapter 1 of the rules are pervasive, strike and underscore of the proposed changes is not practicable. The Attorney General's Office is aware of this and has offered its approval for the rules to be submitted without strike and underscore and has indicated that said approval will be noted on the Notice of Intent.

Rules proposed to be amended:

Chapter 1 – General Provisions: This Chapter of the rules is proposed to be amended to clarify current business practices of the Wyoming Retirement System as administrator of the Fund and as directed by the Board. Following is a summary of the proposed amendments to Chapter 1:

- **Title** – The title of these rules is proposed to change from “Rules of Practice in Contested Matters Before the Volunteer Firemen's Pension Board” to “Rules of Practice Governing Administration of the Volunteer Firemen's Pension Fund.”
- **Section 1: Authority** – Proposed to reflect current statutory authority.
- **Section 2: Definitions** – The proposed changes in this Section remove the current definitions and replace them with a single definition of the term “retirement age.” The main focus of this Section is to inform members that “vesting” in this plan occurs only upon reaching retirement age and that a member is eligible for a retirement benefit (as stated in the table of benefits articulated in W.S. 35-9-608) only when they have reached retirement age. Additionally, any member who ceases contribution payments prior to reaching retirement age is required to withdraw from the fund and receive a refund of their account (contributions plus interest). The current rules permit a member that terminates service as a volunteer fireman to leave their account on deposit and be eligible for a reduced benefit at retirement. The proposed amendments to the rules eliminate the option for a reduced benefit and require withdrawal if, for any reason, contributions cease prior to the member reaching retirement age.
- **Section 3: Notice in Service** – Proposed change to “Service” –

- **Section 3.1 – Determining Total Service Application** - The proposed amendments to this Section would more clearly define the procedures and rules required under USERRA, the federal law related to the rights of military service members; (proposed as **Section 3(a) – Military Service**).
- **Section 3.2 - Actuarially Determined Contributions Made by a Fireman** – The purpose of this proposal is to update current business practices to allow a member to purchase service at an actuarially calculated amount reflecting actual service as a bona fide volunteer fireman in Wyoming prior to enrollment, or re-enrollment, in the Fund. Service credit in the current rules is limited to purchase amounts in whole-year increments. The proposal would allow eligible members to purchase the exact amount of time served; (proposed as **Section 3(b) – Service Purchase**).
- **Section 3.3 - Continuance of Monthly Pension Payments after Retiring from Active Service** – This Section is proposed to be amended to clarify current business practices regarding members who cease active service as volunteer firemen. These members would be allowed to continue to contribute to the Fund only if they have at least ten years of continuous participation in the Fund. Members without ten years of continuous participation would be required to withdraw from the Fund in accordance with the rules. Any member, regardless of years of service, would be required to withdraw from the Fund if they ceased contributing, for any reason, prior to reaching retirement age. This proposal would replace the current provision which allows a member that terminates service to leave their account on deposit and remain eligible for a reduced retirement benefit upon reaching retirement age; (proposed as **Section 3(c) - Continuation of Contributions Following Termination of Active Service and 3(d) – Withdrawal**).
- **Section 3.4 and 3.5 - Continuance of Monthly Pension Payments after Retiring from Active Service due to Disability & Applications to Continue Monthly Pension Plan Payments** – These two sections are proposed to be combined into one section and updated to reflect current business practices; (proposed as **Section 3(e) - Termination of Active Service due to Disability**).
- **Section 4: Meetings** – This Section is proposed to be amended to simplify and clarify Board meeting requirements (proposed as **Section 4(a) - Board Meetings**) and requirements for attendance at volunteer fire department meetings to maintain membership eligibility in the Fund (proposed as **Section 4(b) - Department Meetings**). With regard to proposed Section 4(b), W.S. 35-9-601(a) defines the term “volunteer fireman” as “any individual who ... (ii) During the course of any one (1) year, attends not less than fifty percent (50%) of the monthly volunteer fire department meetings.” The statutory meeting attendance requirement for eligibility in the Fund has been confusing and problematic for the various participating departments. This proposal would require departments to maintain a regular meeting schedule to conduct business and training, and require its members to attend at least 50 percent, and in no case less than six, of those

regularly scheduled meetings. The Board believes this change is necessary to clarify the statutory meeting requirement with the various departments.

- **Section 5 – Contested Cases** – This is a newly proposed section would incorporate the contested case provisions of Chapter 4 of the current rules, which the Board has proposed to repeal. Section 5 would incorporate by reference the Office of Administrative Hearings Rules, Chapter 2, Contested Case Proceedings, edition May 7, 2008, that would provide the procedures and options a member has when contesting a ruling of the Board.
- **Section 6 – Records** – This section incorporates the member account records provisions of Chapter 3, which the Board has proposed to repeal. In addition, the Board has proposed to build into Section 6 provisions for public records requests, which would include both member account records and other public records.

Rules proposed to be repealed:

Chapter 2 – Volunteer Firemen Department Meetings: This rule is proposed to be incorporated into Chapter 1, which would render Chapter 2 redundant. W.S. 35-9-601(a) defines the term “volunteer fireman” as “any individual who ... (ii) During the course of any one (1) year, attends not less than fifty percent (50%) of the monthly volunteer fire department meetings.” The statutory meeting attendance requirement for eligibility in the Fund has been confusing and problematic for the various participating departments. This proposed language in Chapter 1 would require departments to maintain a regular meeting schedule to conduct business and training, and require its members to attend at least 50 percent, and in no case less than six, of those regularly scheduled meetings. The Board believes this change is necessary to clarify the statutory meeting requirement with the various departments.

Chapter 3 – Member Account Records: This rule is proposed to be incorporated into Chapter 1, which would render Chapter 3 redundant.

Chapter 4 – Practices and Procedure for Contested Cases: This rule is proposed to be incorporated into Chapter 1, which would render Chapter 4 redundant. The proposed language would incorporate by reference the Office of Administrative Hearings Rules, Chapter 2 Contested Case Proceedings, edition May 7, 2008.

Chapter 5 – Deminimus Accounts: Section 4 of Chapter 5, which requires a member who withdraws from active service as a volunteer fireman to withdraw from the Fund, conflicts with the existing language of Chapter 1, which allows for a member who withdraws from active service to leave their account on deposit with the Fund and be eligible for a reduced benefit. The proposed amendments to Chapter 1 would incorporate the requirement in Chapter 5 that terminating members take a withdrawal and would remove the authority for members to leave their account on deposit and receive a reduced benefit. Additionally, the provision in Chapter 5 authorizing the system to absorb accounts that are not withdrawn is proposed in the amended language to Chapter 1 (**Section 3(d) – Withdrawal**). Adoption of the proposed amendments to Chapter 1 would make Chapter 5 redundant and obsolete and is therefore proposed for repeal.

Upon such payment, the member shall be credited with service as though no break in service occurred. Any member that does not rejoin the regular rolls of a duly constituted volunteer fire department in Wyoming following return from active military service must withdraw from the Fund and take a refund of their account.

(iii) Any participating member who elects not to make pension contributions during active military service, and who rejoins the regular rolls of a duly constituted volunteer fire department in Wyoming after the time frame outlined in federal law, shall be permitted up to five (5) years from the date of rejoining the regular rolls to make a lump-sum payment to the Fund equal to the amount of the missed contributions with interest. Upon such payment, the member shall be credited with service as though no break in service occurred. Any member that does not rejoin the regular rolls of a duly constituted volunteer fire department in Wyoming following return from active military service must withdraw from the Fund and take a refund of their account.

(b) **Service Purchase.** Any member shall be entitled to make a lump-sum payment, in an actuarially determined amount, for the purpose of receiving service credit for actual service as a volunteer fireman in Wyoming prior to enrollment, or re-enrollment, in the Fund. Service purchased pursuant to this section shall not exceed the total actual service as a bona fide volunteer fireman in Wyoming prior to the member's enrollment, or re-enrollment, in the Fund. The entry age of a member who exercises this option shall reflect the service purchase.

(c) **Continuation of Contributions Following Termination of Active Service.** Any member who has contributed to the Fund for at least ten (10) consecutive years and who terminates active service as a volunteer fireman shall be permitted to continue contributing to the Fund until the member obtains retirement age. Any member who has not contributed to the Fund for at least ten (10) consecutive years and who terminates active service as a volunteer fireman shall not be eligible to continue contributing to the Fund and shall be required to withdraw those contributions and interest in accordance with these rules. A member who withdraws from the Fund shall be paid a distribution of the accumulated contributions and interest in the member's account. Members shall have three (3) months from the close of the first calendar month for which

contributions have not been received by the Fund to make appropriate payments. An account for which appropriate payments have not been received within that time frame shall be deemed delinquent. No interest shall accrue on delinquent accounts. An account that remains delinquent for nine (9) months shall be closed and the associated funds shall be absorbed by the Fund. (i) All public records in the custody of the Wyoming Retirement System ("System") are subject to the Wyoming Public Records Act, W.S. 16-4-201 through 16-4-205, and shall be open for inspection by any person at reasonable times, except as otherwise provided by law or as provided herein. All public records requests shall be made in writing. The request shall contain the name and a description of the record sought.

(ii) All public records responsive to the request shall be made available for inspection at the System during regular business hours and in the presence of a System staff member.

(iii) Upon request, photocopies of the public record shall be produced at the cost of twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per page, with a minimum charge of one dollar (\$1.00), plus required postage. Fees under this section are payable in advance.

(b) Member Account Records. The member account records maintained by the System are privileged and confidential and shall not be disclosed to any third parties, except where the System has received written authorization from the individual whose records are being requested or a court order directs the System to make the records available for inspection or release. Member account records provided under this Section shall be subject to applicable charges authorized by this Chapter.
